Lift access: take Village Gondola from Village Base area; Vista Express lift – exit left to top of course on Loggers Loop. Spectators can access bottom of the race course on foot; non-skiing/boarding gondola ticket available for \$20 at checkin.

Thursday SG training: SG training will be available on Thursday afternoon. Cost \$25 – purchase with racer lift at Gondola ticket office. Mandatory inspection at 1pm, followed by training runs. Late arrivals cannot be accommodated; course access will be strictly controlled for inspection and training runs.

REMINDER: race day checkin is required!! You **must** check in on race day to confirm your participation and ensure you receive any updates about the event program.

Helmets are required for <u>all</u> disciplines!

***** 2017: FIS-certified race helmet is **recommended** for GS, SG, and DH *****

Competitors must be a current member of USSA and Far West Masters. New racers are welcome and may purchase an inexpensive short-term USSA membership license per race day.
