### Diamond Peak SLx2 / SL Mar. 1-2, 2024

After a successful return to racing at Diamond Peak in 2024, we're pleased to again be racing SL at Diamond Peak on the first weekend of March. To take advantage of the excellent SL race venue and the solid execution by the Diamond Peak race crew, we'll be holding 3 SL races over the 2-day weekend. There will be **3 runs per day**, with **SL #2 split over 2 days** - 1st run Sat afternoon after SL #1, 2nd run Sun morning before SL #3.
