UPDATED: Mammoth is offering SG training on Thursday 1/23 from noon to approx. 2pm for \$30, allowing all competitors to get on the race hill before the Fri/Sat races. Pay at the Race Dept office (Team HQ building) and show receipt to the coaches on the hill to access the training session.

REMINDER: race day checkin is required!! You **must** check in on race day to confirm your participation and ensure you receive any updates about the event program.

Helmets are required for all disciplines!

******* FIS-certified race helmet is *REQUIRED* for GS, SG, and DH; flouro wax *BANNED* *******

Competitors must be a current member of US Ski and Snowboard and Far West Masters. New racers are welcome and may purchase a short-term US Ski and Snowboard membership license per race day.
