The annual Bernard Cup trophy races will be held at Palisades Tahoe (Olympic Valley) on Sat-Sun Feb. 1-2, in conjunction with the Friday SL doubleheader at adjacent Alpine Meadows. The 2025 Bernard Cup, held annually at Palisades Tahoe, home area of masters pioneer Bob Bernard, counts both GS race results to determine the winners of the overall age-handicapped Bernard Cup trophy.
